


4th Roadmap of Lithuanian RI's

Historical Trajectories of Lithuanian RIs





Policy-Driven Developments



- For the 1st time, an anticipatory national research infrastructure LIST (*Lithuanian Longitudinal Social Survey*) was selected to the Roadmap, without international equivalent
 - Complementing international ESS, GGP, SHARE, MEDem research with profiles specific to national policies, preeminently to State Progress Strategy "Lithuania's Vision for the Future 'Lithuania 2050'" (2023)
 - Regular panel research, sample 5000
 - Attitudes, values, estimations, behavior of the society
 - Funding provided via special grant to Research Council of Lithuania
- GGP LT was also supported politically in Implementation Provisions of 'Lithuania 2050' and will be funded from governmental sources

Findings



- Strong inter-institutional and interdisciplinary collaboration
- Part of international research ecosystem
- Appreciable role in national social policies
- Gaps: strategy, sustainability, human and financial resources
- Needs: inter-institutional networking, stability, competencies of staff, competencies of users
- Connections: social policies, partially Smart Specialization
- Prospects for investment: upgrading, participation fees, networking, accessibility of data, competencies for use in evidence-informed policy making
